

Bailey Research Career Development Award

The overall goal of this award is to foster research that is innovative and not only increases knowledge, but has practical applications. Any full-time tenured associate professor or professor may apply for an award of \$50,000 per year for two or three years. The award may be used for faculty salary support, staff salary support, graduate student and postdoc support, travel, equipment, hourly labor and supplies.
